## HAPPY CAMPERS

A member of the family that owned New Braunfels' Schlitterbahn water park for years has opened an RV resort in the city. In late May, Stuart and Tasha Blythin opened **Camp Landa** on a downtown site where Tasha's family once manufactured attractions for the water park, which the family sold in 2019. Although the RV resort has a retro-inspired design, it's teeming with modern family-friendly amenities. There's a heated pool with a swim-up bar, pickleball courts (pictured), basketball hoops, cornhole, a playground, a café, and a large communal firepit for roasting s'mores. Plus, shuttles take guests to the nearby Comal River for floating fun. The park has 110 RV sites, some with picnic tables and grills, others with tables and chairs or picnic benches. Five well-appointed cabins with midcentury modern details each sleep up to eight and come with a kitchen and an outdoor grill and dining area. *RV sites start at \$70; cabins at \$185.* ➔ **JILL ROBBINS**
